INTERIM ORDER

1. The case was taken up for hearing on 16.12.2025, as scheduled.
2. At the outset, the respondent (HPPC) submitted that the additional affidavit dated 01.12.2025 filed by the petitioner does not contain verified invoices, Purchase orders etc. The respondent further requested for grant of four weeks' time to file its reply after submission of complete documents by the petitioner.
3. Ms. Natasha Debroy, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the requisite documents shall be filed within 10 days. She further submitted that the petitioner would require three weeks' time to file its rejoinder to the reply of HPPC.
4. Upon hearing the parties, the Commission directs the petitioner to file complete invoices in support of its project cost, duly arranged and summarized along with relevant bank statements, under affidavit. The filing should be complete within 10 days from the date of this order, with an advance copy to the respondent. The respondent may file its

comprehensive reply within four weeks thereafter with a copy to the petitioner. The petitioner may, if so desire, file its rejoinder within three weeks thereafter.

5. The case shall be listed for arguments on 23.04.2026.
