INTERIM ORDER

The Commission noted with concern the absence of Respondent DHBVN and directed the MD/DHBVN to nominate a Standing Counsel along with a Nodal Officer to attend the cases at the first instance in the HERC Court Room. Further, any authorisation to another licensee or co-respondent be submitted in Court for record.
4. Acceding to the request of the Respondent, the Commission adjourns the matter and directs the Respondents to file their replies within three (3) weeks, with advance copy to the Petitioner.
5. The matter shall come up next on 16.04.2026.
